Objectives: By the end of the workshop, attendees will be able to: i) read and critically appraise a systematic review; ii) formulate a clear review question; iii) perform a literature search; iv) assess the risk of bias of included studies; v) develop an analysis plan (including basic steps for meta-analysis); and vi) apply the GRADE process. The focus will be on Tuberculosis. Useful resources will be provided.

Who should attend this course? Those who will be performing a systematic review in the future and those who want to find and read systematic reviews conducted by others. Knowledge about evidence-based health care would be helpful, but is not essential.

Clinical Director Profile: Karen Steingart and her collaborators have published systematic reviews and meta-analyses on TB topics. These reviews have contributed to the evidence base for the development of several recent WHO guidelines on TB. Karen is passionate about systematic reviews and works with teams from all over the world.
